UCI Regulations

The competition will be conducted under the rules and regulations established by the Union Cycliste Internationale (UCI). Only riders who hold a licence for one of the international categories under articles 1.1.036 or 1.1.037 have the right to take part in events on the international calendar, following the provisions of Article 1.1.035 of the UCI Cycling Regulations. Only riders with at least 10 points in the UCI ranking on the day of the event will be admitted to participate in Class 1 events, following the provisions of Article 3.8.003 of the UCI Regulations.

Scale of Penalties

Only the UCI Scale of Penalties shall apply for any infractions during the competition.

Competition Regulations

Fiorenzuola International Track Women and Men (28° Sei Giorni delle Rose) is a UCI event. The Elite races (Omnium – Madison – Points Race – Elimination – Scratch) are Class 1 races. The Under 23 races (Points Race – Elimination – Scratch) are Class 2 races. Participation is open for Men Elite, Women Elite, Men Under 23, and Women Under 23. The races award points for the UCI Track Rankings, following the provisions of Articles 3.3.001, 3.3.002 and 3.3.010 of the UCI Track Regulations.

Competition Program and Schedule

The competition schedule, including race categories, start times, and durations, is detailed in the official program attached. Participants and teams should review the schedule to be well-prepared for their respective events. The program, along with any specific modifications or communications, will be distributed via the official organization channels. The organization will communicate the confirmation of the next day's program or any changes daily, considering weather forecasts, qualifications for races, and other relevant situations.

Communication Policy

During the competition, official communications will be held within the official WhatsApp Channel, and the official website (www.fiorenzuolatrack.eu). Social media accounts associated with the event will serve only promotional and informational purposes for the general public and are not considered official.

A specific WhatsApp group will be created for organizational information (meal reservations, general information). For further information, contact the location manager or the secretariat.

Track Description

The event will take place on an outdoor concrete track with a length of 394 meters and a maximum inclination of 33°. The track surface coating is concrete.

Track Opening Schedule

August 1st: 9am – 11am and 4pm – 6pm

August 2nd: 9am – 11am and 4pm – 6pm

August 3rd: 9am – 11am and 2pm – 4pm

August 4th: 9am – 11am and 4pm – 6pm

August 5th: 9am – 11am and 4pm – 6pm

August 6th: 9am – 11am and 2pm – 4pm

Please note that the track will be open only for materials check. These are not meant to be training sessions, medical service is not provided. For information or assistance during the sessions, refer to the team relations manager, Jan Kopac (+420 72404857).

Venue Information

Below are key locations for the event.

Competition Headquarters: Located under the grandstands, at the back where the gray door is (beside the restrooms). It hosts the media center, conference room, and the commissaire's office.

Confirmation Area: Inside the velodrome, near the red building. It hosts all race confirmations and numbers distribution.

Doping Control Station: Situated near the main entrance, in the building at the left.

Media Centre: Located the same place as the Headquarters.

Direction Office: Located in the side part of the track, accessible only with a reservation from the organization director or the location manager.

Additionally, all staff members wearing white polo shirts with the “6 giorni” logo are prepared to provide participants with any necessary information.

Starters Confirmation and Rider Numbers Distribution

Participants must confirm their starters at the confirmation area on the same day as the event, until one hour before the beginning of the first daily session. Rider numbers will be distributed at the same location and time following confirmation. The specific time is indicated in the race program.

Award Ceremonies Program

The award ceremony will take place immediately after the end of the races, on the podium inside the track. If, for any reason, the ceremony must be rescheduled, the organization will provide information as soon as possible. In any case, riders involved must present themselves wearing competition clothing.

Prize Money

The prize money follows UCI financial obligations, with principles of gender equality. Prizes are awarded to the first three classified of the final classification of each race.

The prize money for Class 1 races is: 1st place €200 - 2nd place €150 - 3rd place €100, for each race.

The prize money for Class 2 races is: 1st place €100 - 2nd place €60 - 3rd place €40, for each race.

Prize money will be paid via bank transfer at the end of the event. In order to collect it, athletes must fill out the prize money form in all parts and send it to the organization team.

Press

Media are allowed in the infield zone of the track only with organization media accreditations, wearing a blue bib. Media accreditation can be collected during the opening hours of the media center, located under the stands, accessible exclusively for accredited journalists during the scheduled opening time. Press accreditation is open until July 30th via mail to 6giornidellerose@gmail.com. Media Center will open everyday at 4pm.
