#### SPECIAL RACE REGULATIONS

#### 1. UCI Guidelines

The "6 Giorni delle Rose – Fiorenzuola International Track Women and Men" is held under the auspices and according to the regulations, decisions, conditions, and instructions of the UCI. The UCI scale of penalties will solely apply.

Only athletes who have at least 10 points in the UCI ranking on the day of the event will be admitted participating in the events valid for Class 1, in accordance with the provisions of article 3.8.003 of the UCI Track Regulations.

# 2. Participation and Registration

Fiorenzuola International Track is an UCI Class 1 event for Olympic races, Class 2 for the other races, the participation is open for Men Elite, Women Elite, Men Under 23 and Women Under 23. The races awards points for the track nations and individual classification, in accordance with the provisions of articles 3.3.002 and 3.3.010 of the UCI Track Regulations.

#### 3. Enrolment and bibs distributions

License Check and the bibs distributions will be held every day inside the Velodrome as stated in the race schedule.

## 4. Team Managers' Meeting

The technical meeting between the team managers, the Commissaires' Panel and the Organizer is scheduled on June 29th, 9pm GMT+2, via video conference.

#### 5. Communication

The official press releases will be with the 2023 Fiorenzuola Track WhatsApp Group.

# 6. Communiques Distribution

In order to reduce environmental impact, no printed communiques will be distributed. Every official communique will be send via the 2023 Fiorenzuola Track WhatsApp group and via the official website www.fiorenzuolatrack.eu.

## 7. Prizes

The prize money for Class 1 races is given following the UCI financial obligation, following the principles of gender equality. Prizes are awarded to the first three classified of the final classification of each race. The prize money for Class 1 Omnium is: 1st place 200,00€ - 2nd place 150,00€ - 3<sup>rd</sup> place 100,00€.

The prize money for Class 1 Madison race is: 1<sup>st</sup> place 400,00€ - 2<sup>nd</sup> place 300,00€ - 3<sup>rd</sup> place 200,00€, for each team member, since the race takes place in multiple days.

The prize money for Class 2 races, following the principles of gender equality, is: 1st place 100,00€ - 2<sup>nd</sup> place 60,00€ - 3<sup>rd</sup> place 40,00€, for each race.

The money prize must be collected from the secretariat (under the grandstand) only on the date of the competition by 11 pm at the latest carrying an identity document and an IBAN code.

### 8. Award Ceremony

The award ceremony will take place immediately after the end of the races, on the podium inside the track. Riders involved must present themselves in race clothing.

#### 9. Riders' Area

Riders' area is located outside the track, in the field near the grandstand. The organization will not provide bike storage before, during and after the competition. Each team is considered responsible of their own equipment during his stay.

# 10. Antidoping control

Anti-doping tests will take place in specific rooms located at the permanence, according to the UCI anti- doping Regulations and to the laws provided by Italian legislation.

### 11. Special Madison regulation

The UCI Class 1 Madison Final Classification will be composed with the points gained in the SGR Madison and SGR Flying Lap during the three days of races.

The points are assigned as specificized below:

Madison: 20-12-10-8-6-4 Flying Lap: 10-6-5-4-3-2

Madison Final: All sprints' points (and 20 points for laps gained or lost) will go directly to the UCI

class 1 final Madison classification.

#### 12. Side Events

A side event open to the "Giovanissimi" category is scheduled on July 6<sup>th</sup>.

#### 13. Press

Photographers and journalists are allowed in the infield zone of the track only with the organization media accreditations. Media accreditation can be collected during the opening hours of the accreditation center. The press room is located under the stands, accessible exclusively for accredited journalists in the scheduled opening time. The press accreditation is open until June 30<sup>th</sup> via mail to 6giornidellerose@gmail.com.

#### 14. Program

The organization wants to clarify that every day at 5 pm, they will communicate the confirmation of the next day's program or any changes, considering the weather forecast, any qualification foreseen for the races and particular situations to be evaluated. Race program follows.
